## Master of Divinity Advanced Placement for Boyce College Graduates

To receive advanced placement for any given SBTS course (right column, below), a student's Boyce transcript *must* indicate that the corresponding Boyce course/s was/were completed at a grade of B (3 on a 4 pt. scale) or higher (note: in some cases, more than one Boyce course must be passed with a B or better to qualify for advanced placement). Unless indicated otherwise, advanced placement allows a student to take an elective course *only within the same Division, and preferably within the same Department*, as the replaced required course. (Note: Although a student may qualify for advanced placement in a particular course, he may still take the required SBTS course if he deems that of greater value.)
