Programs Offered by the Boyce TEP for 2009-2010

The Boyce Teacher Education Department functions under the Division of Applied Studies and will initially provide the two majors of Elementary Education P-5 and Integrated Music Education P-12, each culminating in the Bachelor of Science (BS) degree. These degree programs have been approved by the Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education as of April 2009.

Both programs will be under the direction of the Department Chair of the Teacher Education Program (TEP) with the Music Education program under the direct supervision of the Department Coordinator of the Music Education Program.

With the goal of achieving Kentucky state approval to admit students to the Boyce TEP during the 2009-10 fall academic semester, Boyce students may begin the process of making application to be admitted to the Boyce TEP. The Boyce TEP is committed to the goal of having a fully accredited teacher preparation unit by the academic year 2012-2013. The Boyce TEP will also be recognized and approved by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), giving Boyce teacher education graduates ACSI certification for teaching in Christian schools.

The Curriculum Contracts for each of these two program offerings are attached. The Elementary Education P-5 major requires 129 credit hours of study, and the Integrated Music Education P-12 major requires 144 credit hours of study.
