SPRING, 2010 REGISTRATION NOTES

1. Boyce College students may not register for Southern Seminary Master's level courses without written permission from Boyce College. Contact the Office of Academic Advising.
2. Students must complete two semesters of English Composition (EN 101 and EN 102 or equivalent) before enrolling in 200-400 level courses.
3. This form is to supplement registration information available on line. Check the Boyce College web site for more information.
4. In planning your schedule, you may pick up the form "Course List: Fall, 2009--Summer, 2011" from Carver 209. It lists the courses that will be offered each term through the Summer, 2011.
5. It is especially important that you notice the courses listed in the Boyce catalog as "Major" or "Minor" requirements for your program, since some of these courses are not offered every year. Make sure you meet any prerequisites for the course. Contact your Department Coordinator for more information.
6. If you need advice in planning your schedule, contact Boyce College's Office of Academic Advising, (502) 897-4502.
7. SENIORS: If you intend to transfer in any of your final 30 hours, you must first contact Matt Emadi in the Office of Academic Advising, Carver 112C, (502) 897-4502.
8. NOTE: Boyce College follows a different schedule than Southern Seminary for the Spring semester. Boyce Spring classes begin on Tuesday, January 19th.
