

HANDS ON WITH THE INTERNATIONAL MISSION BOARD

Hands On is an once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for Boyce College students to serve in missions overseas for one semester under the supervision of IMB missionaries. Students have the opportunity to serve through a variety of avenues such as art, music, sports and ESL (teaching English as a second language).

HOW DO I APPLY AND WHAT IS THE COST?

Students who are interested in the Hands On program apply directly with the IMB. Once approved, students pay a set price to the IMB of \$2600.00, which covers the student's airfare, room and board, and local transportation as well as limited insurance coverage.



EARN UP TO 12 HOURS ACADEMIC CREDIT

Qualified students can earn up to 12 hours general elective credit at Boyce College (MS 336, MS 461, MS 462 and MS 489) for their participation in the Hands On program at a 100% tuition discount. Students must meet certain pre-requisites for enrollment in these courses. For more information, students should contact Dr. Carlton, Director of the World Impact Center.

WHAT IS THE WORLD IMPACT CENTER?

The World Impact Center, located in Carver Hall 105, is one of the missions department's tools for promoting global missions campus-wide. Students and faculty receive a newsletter monthly from the center with information on mission opportunities, global prayer needs and Boyce students serving on the field in North America and around the world.

The World Impact Center takes every opportunity to provide students with a chance to practically apply what they are learning in the classroom. Boyce College-sponsored mission trips are an example of how students can receive hands on training in cross-cultural evangelism and church-planting skills. Each year, the World Impact Center sponsors at least two mission trips designed specifically for Boyce students. A qualified Boyce faculty member leads these student trips, and students also have the option of earning three hours course credit.



The World Impact Center also houses materials from the International Mission Board (IMB) and the North American Mission Board (NAMB). BOYCE MISSIONS LINK

Missions Link is a student organization that promotes and encourages mission involvement among the student body. Our goal is to provide students of all majors with opportunities to experience and learn about important issues in missions in addition to their time in the classroom. Members typically meet together once a month to focus on specific issues related to global missions.



Four officers are elected each year that are responsible for planning and leading events. These officers strive to keep abreast of what is happening in missions globally, and especially what is happening here at Boyce College.
