Professional Interview

Description: The professional interview is the last step of the application process for admittance to the Educator Preparation Program at Boyce College. This interview is designed to evaluate applicant's professionalism and oral communication skills.

Requirements: The TEP applicant will be required to schedule their meeting with the EPP coordinator (BoyceTEP@sbts.edu). The coordinator will confirm the date/time of the interview. The applicant is required to arrive at least 15 minutes before his/her interview time. It is required that the applicant bring two copies of his/her Philosophy of Education assignment and present those to the interview committee. Applicant should dress professionally for the professional interview.
